# Comprehensive Support for Foreign Women Victims of Human Trafficking and Prostituted Women

Co-funded by the European Union – Asylum, Migration and  
Integration Fund (AMIF)

The NGO Fiet carries out this project with the aim of protecting, supporting, and promoting the comprehensive recovery of foreign women who are victims of trafficking for the purpose of sexual exploitation, as well as prostituted women and their sons and daughters.

The program operates in the Community of Madrid, the Valencian Community, Galicia, the Basque Country, and Melilla, and is structured around three main pillars: detection, comprehensive assistance, and the process of integration and child protection. The project plans to support 1,335 foreign women who are in situations of trafficking, possible trafficking, or vulnerability in prostitution contexts, offering them direct assistance throughout the different stages of intervention. With a human-rights-based and non-revictimizing approach, the project seeks to offer women real life opportunities, strengthening their emotional well-being, safety, and inclusion process.

This program is co-financed by the European Union, which contributes to improving mechanisms of protection, detection, and integration for people most vulnerable to human trafficking.
